If you do not leave the property the claimant also will be able to ask the court bailiff to evict you and ask the court to take steps to obtain payment. This is called 'enforcing the order and money judgment'.

Payments should be made to the claimant at the place where you would normally pay your monthly repayments. If you need more information about making payments you should contact the claimant. The court cannot accept any payments.
